

**DIRECTIONS to the
HYATT REGENCY PHILADELPHIA at PENN'S LANDING**

DRIVING FROM NEW YORK/NEW JERSEY

Driving from New Jersey/New York City is about 100 mi and takes approximately 2 hours, not including traffic delays. For directions from your exact location, use Google Maps or a related search engine. Remember to save receipts for tolls and gas for reimbursement.

Once over the bridge in Philadelphia take I-95 South to Exit 20 (Washington Avenue/Columbus Boulevard). Make a left onto Columbus Boulevard. The hotel is located one mile north on the right.

There is a paid parking garage which costs \$21/night plus tax for hotel guests. CIR will reimburse you for this charge, but will not pay for Valet Parking.

DRIVING FROM BALTIMORE/WASHINGTON DC

From I-95 North or South (within PA): Take I-95 to Exit 20 (Washington Avenue/Columbus Boulevard). Make a left onto Columbus Boulevard. The hotel is located one mile north on the right.

FROM PHILADELPHIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

A *Taxi* at Ground Transportation near baggage claim will cost approximately \$30 to the Hyatt Regency Hotel at Penn's Landing. Save your receipt for reimbursement.

The *Lady Liberty shuttle service* costs \$10 per person. The vans run every 10-15 minutes from 5:30 AM to 12:00 AM and make multiple stops. At the baggage claim look for the Ground Transportation counter and dial 27 for pickup. The number is (215) 724-8888. Save your receipt for reimbursement.

Go Green! The *Philadelphia public transportation system*, known as *SEPTA* is connected to the airport. It takes approximately 50 minutes to get to the Hyatt. The closest stop to the Hyatt is at 2nd and Market Streets (Blue Line) and is a 5 minute walk to the Hyatt Regency Hotel at Penn's Landing. One way fare for trains is \$2.00. Visit www.septa.org for more info. Save your receipt for reimbursement.

FROM AMTRAK TRAIN STATION (30th Street Station, 4 miles from hotel)

Taking a *Taxi* immediately outside the Amtrak Station will cost approximately \$15.

Go Green! The *Philadelphia public transportation system*, known as *SEPTA* is connected to the Amtrak Train Station. It is 20 minutes to 2nd and Market Streets (Blue Line) and a 5 minute walk to the Hyatt Regency Hotel at Penn's Landing. Visit www.septa.org for info. One way fare is \$2.00. Save your receipt.
