


As a result of the voluntary withdrawal of accreditation from the ACGME for the above named programs at St. Vincent's Manhattan effective June 30, 2010, the residents named on the attached list have been placed on an "orphan" status and will be allowed to enter a program at your institution effective July 1, 2010.

Under current Medicare regulations, both direct and indirect GME payments (DME and IME) for those residents may be funded by CMS at the funding level of your institution should you be at or above your "cap" until the residents complete their program.


Upon return of this memo signed by you agreeing to accept the specifically named resident (s), our VP of Reimbursement and Finance will officially request CMS to transfer GME funding for those residents from St. Vincent's Manhattan to your institution. You will receive a copy of that letter to CMS.
