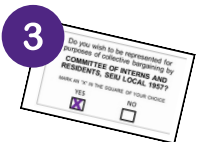
**Check in at the voting station:** an NLRB agent and 2 observers\* will check for your name on the eligible voter list.

\*Observers serve an important role in an NLRB election: to ensure the election is conducted in a fair + impartial manner, so each voter can make their choice freely in secret ballot election.



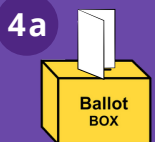

After checking in: **the agent will hand you a ballot** and direct you to a private voting booth.

**Mark your ballot with an X for YES.** Do NOT sign or make any other mark on your ballot.

**Voting on an Unchallenged Ballot:**

**Fold your ballot** before leaving the voting booth. Then deposit your ballot into the ballot box.



4b

**Voting on a Challenged Ballot:**

**\*Fold the ballot** before leaving the voting booth.

\*The agent will direct you to put your ballot in an envelope, seal it and then place it in the ballot box.

\*Ballots cast at a location other than the assigned location will be subject to challenge but the challenges will likely be resolved and counted at the official count on **Jan. 29**.

\*Any challenges related to voter eligibility will be addressed after the official count.



**If you notice any suspicious activity:** Flag the NLRB agent at the polling place.
