This Benefits-At-A-Glance describes the benefits provided through the Voluntary Hospitals House Staff Benefits Plan (VHHSBP) for you and your covered dependents as of July 1.

Residency is demanding. That's why VHHSBP Trustees recognize the importance of providing additional benefits coverage to help ease that burden. The only authorized information concerning your benefits is in writing from the Board of Trustees acting in their official capacity and whose sole decision regarding benefits is final. The trustees reserve the right to change or discontinue the eligibility rules and the type and amounts of benefits under this Plan at any time.

In the event of any conflict between the description of your benefits in this Benefits-At-A-Glance and the terms of the applicable Summary Plan Description and any amendments (SPD), the SPD shall control.

Eligibility: Who is Covered?

After you enroll in the VHHSBP, you and eligible dependents will receive the comprehensive benefits provided in this plan. Eligible dependents include:

- Spouse, children up to age 26, same-sex and opposite-sex domestic partner

Enrollment

To enroll in coverage:

- **Complete a membership form within 31 days after your first day of work.**
- You can find your membership form on your hospital page by visiting cirseiu.org and selecting your hospital from the drop-down menu or map then click "Join CIR."

You and your enrolled family members' coverage starts on your first day of work.

Outside of orientation and open enrollment (July) there are circumstances where special enrollment is possible. Please see [HERE](#) for a HIPAA Notice of Special Enrollment Rights.

What You Need to Enroll

During open enrollment in July you will need to provide:

- A Social Security Number (SSN) for you or your covered dependents.
- A copy of a marriage license or birth certificate(s) for children. If you are missing either of these documents, you can submit this affidavit instead via this update form.
- A Domestic Partner Application, if you are enrolling a domestic partner. You can find the Domestic Partnership Application HERE.

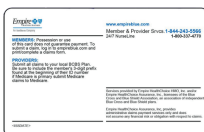

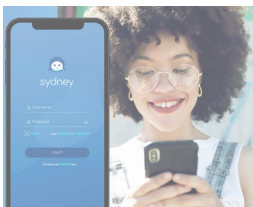

Out-Of-Network Benefit

You may receive services from an out-of-network provider, however, you will receive the greatest value when you go in-network. If you choose an out-of-network provider, you will receive a maximum of \$50 per year toward an eye exam and \$150 toward materials. You must file a claim with Davis Vision to be reimbursed.

Your VHHSBP Supplemental Mental Health Benefit provides a maximum annual reimbursement amount of \$5,000 per individual.

- Outpatient mental health benefits will be reimbursed at 100% of your out-of-pocket expenses, including copayments, coinsurance, and/or deductible charges, not to exceed \$200 per office visit.
- You must complete one claim per resident or eligible dependent and attach the Explanation of Benefits (EOB) received from Anthem along with a receipt showing proof of payment to the provider.
- Claims for this benefit must be submitted within one year from the date of service.
- Claims must be submitted through the [CIR Benefits Fund Member Portal](#). Use the QR code below to register or log in.

Using & Getting Reimbursed for Your Supplemental Mental Health Benefits

1. Find a licensed therapist and book an appointment

IN-NETWORK

2. **Pay the co-pay**
Maintain the Proof of Payment (receipt) for your records

OUT-OF-NETWORK

2. **Pay the provider and obtain the *superbill from the provider**
Maintain the Proof of Payment (receipt) for your records

3. **Your provider will submit the claim to the insurance carrier**
You will receive an explanation of benefits. EOB's take an avg 15-20 business days to process

3. **You must submit the *superbill to Anthem**
You will receive an explanation of benefits. EOB's take an avg 15-20 business days to process

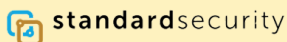

Your Disability Benefits

For purposes of our disability benefits, “disabled” means you can no longer perform the duties of your occupation due to accidental bodily injury, sickness, or a related medical condition, including pregnancy or childbirth. You must also be under the care of a licensed provider as defined by the state in which you work.



Short-Term Disability

Coverage begins on the eighth (8th) day of your disability. The maximum benefit payable is 60% of your weekly salary, up to \$692 per week, for up to 26 weeks. For complete guidelines, refer to your Summary Plan Description (SPD) booklet located on your hospital Benefits Page under “Important Links.” If you are going out on a disability leave, contact your employer as soon as possible.

Guardian Long-Term Disability

The LTD plan pays you 60% of your monthly salary, up to a maximum of \$3,500 a month, in the event of a disability. LTD benefits typically start if you are still disabled after 26 continuous weeks. During your training and upon termination of employment, you have the option to obtain a guaranteed individual policy, subject to certain conditions.



Eligible CIR members have access to an exclusive opportunity to secure permanent, portable disability insurance designed to protect both your current income and your future earning potential. You may obtain up to \$15,000 of specialty specific disability insurance coverage that can increase the amount of income you would receive during an unexpected accident or illness.

Benefits Continued

Gender-Affirming Care



Gender-affirming care benefits are provided to those who need access to medical and surgical care to transition to the appropriate gender. It includes knowledgeable primary care, HRT and prescription medication, access to gender-specific transition-related care as well as mental health outpatient care.

Guardian Life Insurance

If you die, a \$125,000 benefit goes to your beneficiary. You will receive a \$20,000 death benefit if your spouse or domestic partner dies.

Ancillary Death Benefit

Ancillary Death Benefit Provides up to \$5,000 for transportation of the remains of the deceased to a place of burial more than 200 miles from New York City.

Accidental Dismemberment Benefit

Includes payments for the loss of a limb as the result of an accident on or off the job.

The VHHSBP of the Committee of Interns & Residents Legal Services Plan is a pre-paid legal services benefit which provides legal assistance to resident physicians and qualifying family members on covered matters. The Plan connects you with lawyers who can help with an array of legal issues.

Employment Contract Review Benefit

You Pay Substantially Less than the CIRLS Discounted Cost*

- Review of your written contract by an attorney who specializes in physician employment contracts, followed by a discussion about the terms of the contract by phone or video conference.
- Covers contracts for employment in 29 states and Washington, DC.
- The typical cost for contract review can range from \$600 to \$1,300, but CIRLS has negotiated discounted rates for residents and fellows employed by participating CIR hospitals. In addition, CIRLS will pay \$200 toward the discounted fee.
- Receipt of a CIR-prepared post-residency employment contract packet designed to enable you to better understand your contract. Includes a valuable checklist.

New York State Paid Family Leave



In 2016, New York enacted the nation’s strongest and most comprehensive Paid Family Leave policy so working families would not have to choose between caring for their loved ones and risking their economic security.

Paid Family Leave provides eligible employees job-protected, paid time off to:

- bond with a newly born, adopted or fostered child,
- care for a family member with a serious health condition, or
- assist loved ones when a spouse, domestic partner, child, or parent is deployed abroad on active military service.

What are the benefits?

- **Duration of leave - Maximum 12 weeks**
- **Weeks Maximum Weekly Payout - \$1,228.53 (2026)**

Your Additional Education Benefits

Quality Improvement (QI) Patient Safety Scholarships

VHHSBP is committed to offering residents additional education and training to help you deliver safe, efficient and effective care to your patients.

QI/Training Scholarships provides scholarships for **eligible covered residents to attend one approved QI/Patient Safety Education and Training program** available in the U.S.

Participants will be eligible to receive a scholarship of **up to \$3,000 per residency year** to cover expenses related to registration, travel, and tuition.

Covered residents accessing this benefit are responsible for securing time off (vacation or education leave time) to attend or participate in these educational opportunities.

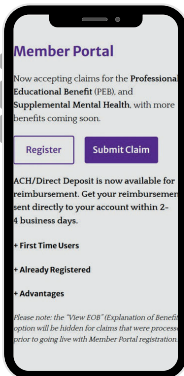
